A Message from Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." (Hebrews 13:8)

This is our theme verse for 2022. As we celebrate 125 years of ministry at St. Paul in Millington, we must always remember the reason and purpose for it. We have gathered over the years to worship the true God, receive His gifts, and share the Word of Christ to all. God willing, we will do these things for many, many more years to come.

In 2022, we will remember and celebrate the past 125 years. It's good to remember our humble beginnings: From the original church building and one room school house, through all the building projects down through years. From a few families worshiping and learning, to many families daily coming in and out of our building. From one pastor and teacher, to all the staff, teachers, and pastors we've had over the years. In all of this, through all the changes, Jesus Christ was with us and He never changed.

In 2022, we'll also reflect on where we are today. Our building debt is paid in full. We've weathered many storms, both literal storms as well as spiritual ones. Our school has 145 children from pre-school through 8th grade this school year. Our staff, teachers, and pastors are experienced and dedicated in their service to the Lord and each other. We still gather to worship the true God, receive His gifts, and share the Word of Christ to all. Again, in all of this, even amidst our current world of constant change, Jesus Christ is with us and He isn't changing.

Finally, in 2022, we'll spend time looking at our future. What will St. Paul look like in 5

years? 10 years? 25 years? 125 years? This is where you play a significant part. Will we focus on caring for our members and school families? Or, intentionally reach out to those around us who are not yet part of our community? Or will we do both? Even as we deal with "today" every day, the ministry we do "today" will shape our "tomorrow". And while the future is uncertain for us, for Jesus Christ the future is known and in His capable, nail-scarred hands. He will be with us to the end of time. And He will never change.

Much has changed over the last 125 years. Much will change in the future. But Jesus, according to His eternal divinity, is unchangeable. His covenant of grace also doesn't change. Jesus Christ and all that He promises is the same yesterday and today and forever. Believers of any time and place have but one person for their faith, forgiveness, and life everlasting: Jesus Christ! To Him alone be glory now and forever!


