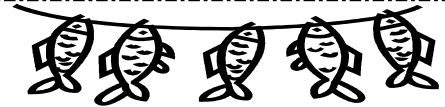


Spring pictures from Lifetouch will be coming home shortly. The directions are included in the picture packet. You may also purchase items online.
