What do you think it taught them? (See the "Lord's Prayer" in Luther's Small Catechism for more about daily bread.) On the 6th day they gathered twice as much so they could rest on the Sabbath. Why is it important to stop & take time to worship?

Prayer: Lord, You provide for everything I need. Keep my eyes open and willing to serve those who may have less than I do. Amen.

26. THE 10 COMMANDMENTS - Exodus 20

Optional things to talk/think about after your reading:

- When God came down to the mountain, the people were scared. Describe a scary time in your life. ٠
- None of us can keep God's Law perfectly, but Jesus did for us. What does this mean for us today? Also, think about 1 person you know who needs to hear the Good News of Jesus, and pray for an opportunity to share it with them.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, Your Law shows us our sin and our need for a Savior. Thank You for sending Jesus to save us so that our sins are forgiven. It has changed our lives! Give us Your Holy Spirit and an opportunity to share this greatest of news with others. Amen.

Optional things to talk/think about after your reading:

- Have you ever made a friend so mad he or she didn't want to be your friend anymore? How did that make you feel?
- God told Moses to use sacrifices to take away the sins of the people. All of these sacrifices pointed ahead to the day Jesus would go to the cross and die in our place. What event happened in the Temple when Jesus died? (See Matthew 27:51)

Prayer: Lord God, thank You for the tabernacle which showed us a little more about the work of Jesus. Thank You for forgiving me for Jesus' sake. Amen.

28. THE GOLDEN CALF --- Exodus 32

Optional things to talk/think about after your reading:

- Have you ever done something that made your mom or dad really, really mad?
- The word "atonement" means "to pay the penalty for sin". Who atoned our sins and how? What does this mean?

Prayer: Lord God, I am sorry for the times I forget Your loving promises and do things that make You angry. Please forgive me for Jesus' sake, because He died on the cross in my place. In Jesus' name. Amen.

29. THE 12 SPIES --- Numbers 13-14

Optional things to talk/think about after your reading:

- Why can it be easy to doubt the power of God, like so many of the men did in this story?
- Have you ever wanted to do something good, but your friends were too scared to join you? Why weren't Caleb & Joshua afraid to occupy the land?

Prayer: Lord, there are times when I'm afraid in spite of all Your promises to me. Give me strength to be courageous in my faith. Amen.

30. WATER FROM A ROCK -- Numbers 20:2-13

Optional things to talk/think about after your reading:

- ٠ Do you complain a lot? What kind of things make you want to complain?
- Why do you think God dealt so harshly with Moses & Aaron? ٠

Prayer: Lord God, sometimes people make me upset, and sometimes things in my life do. Forgive me for not always being kind, patient, and thankful. Help me see how good, kind, and patient You are with me. In Jesus' name. Amen.
