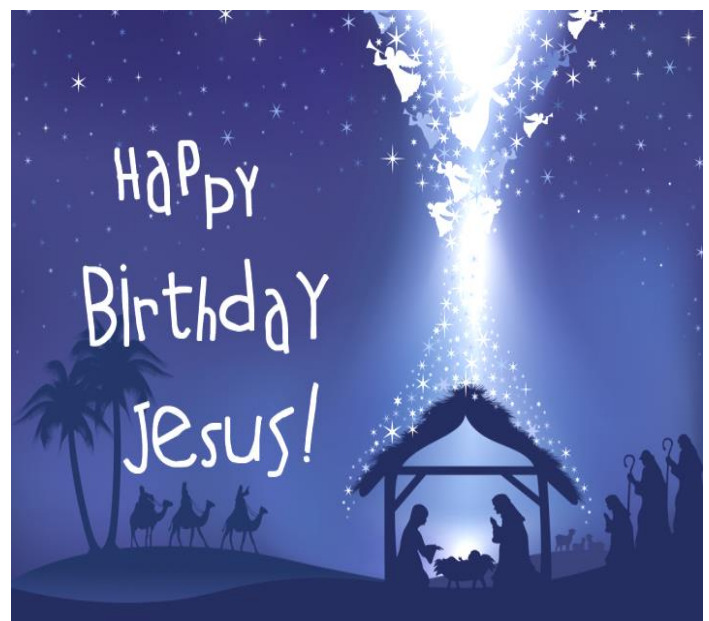
**Latchkey is looking for some gently used toys,** if you are cleaning and would like to donate some, it would be greatly appreciated.
