A Message from Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The situation is very similar.

When Jesus came into the world, He came as a vulnerable human baby. There was political unrest (between the Jewish people and the governing power of the Roman empire) and racial issues throughout the land. Joseph and Mary were probably struggling financially. Because Mary's prenatal care was far less than what we can provide today, Jesus was at risk of dying from the moment He was conceived. Now, babies can be aborted at any moment. Travel was not easy and the journey they took to Bethlehem would have been discouraged considering her condition, but it was neces-Now, we are limited in travel sarv by law. due to potential spread of COVID. His parents wrapped him in cloths and laid him in a manger because there was no room for them in appropriate housing. Holding Him in their arms was the only other protection they could provide Him. Even today, there are homeless

and unsafe housing arrangements.

The Son of God came to experience our vulnerability, because He loves us. His life was always in danger, but the ultimate cause of His death was intentionally embraced. He was given the name Jesus because He came to save His people from their sins (Mt. 1:21). He was not protected from the suffering and death on the cross. His life was intended to end in this horrible death. The world needed a Savior then, and we still need a Savior now. Thankfully, we have this confident hope and eternal joy, despite the uncertain world we live in. No matter what is coming in the future, we hold on to the promises of our God. "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." So, we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?" (Heb. 13:5-6). His love for

us is the same yesterday, today and forever (because He remains the same).

Did you notice before Thanksgiving how people started to direct their attention toward Christmas to take their mind off of the darkness of our present world? Here is my word of encouragement. Consider how Jesus remains the greatest present (as a gift and in terms of time). The situation has always been very similar.




