October



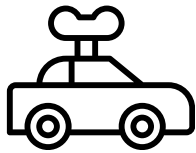
Participate in Hall-o-ween or Trunk-or-Treat.

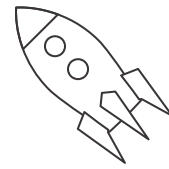
November

These are missions that can be completed anytime. They are listed by category.

Worship

- Attend a service you normally wouldn't
- Sit in a different spot in church and meet someone new
- Attend church (in-person or online) 4 weeks in a row
- Attend a Wednesday service (in-person or online) during Advent or Lent

Spiritual Growth

- Attend Bible Study (in-person or online)
- Tithe 10% more than you normally do two times in a row
- Start a daily devotional habit
- Find a new Christian artist you have not listened to before and pick a favorite song from their collection
- Handwrite your favorite book of the Bible

Prayer

- Pray for your Pastors
- Pray for the teachers and the staff
- Pray for a student

- Pick a random person you see in church and ask how you can pray for them
- Pick a Psalm to pray everyday until you get through them all

Volunteer

- Volunteer to help at the school
- Volunteer to help at church
- Volunteer to help with the Saginaw Rescue Mission
- Volunteer to be on a committee for one of our monthly activities

- Attend a St. Paul sporting event
