8. I will only make copies of software from school computers or networks in which I have been given permission.
9. I understand and respect that the school uphold the copyright laws of the United States as it applies to computer programs or licenses owned by the school.

- * Creation of a home page on a district owned server without St. Paul Lutheran School's identification and authorization.
